

To Apply:

- 1) Complete this form: <http://goo.gl/forms/KR0HJhJrRj>
- 2) Make your audition recording using either audio or audio + video.
 - a) Tenor Trombonists, please record the following:
 - Two contrasting Blazevich or Rochut/Bordogni etudes OR two movements from a concerto or sonata.
 - A 3-octave C-major scale in quarter notes at quarter = 120
 - b) Bass Trombonists, please record the following:
 - Contrasting Tyrell or Rochut/Bordogni etudes OR two movements from a concerto or sonata.
 - A 3-octave A-flat major scale in quarter notes at quarter = 120
- 3) Email your recording directly as an mp3 to Dr. Van Hof, OR email a link to your recording loaded up to YouTube, Vimeo, Soundcloud, Dropbox, Google Drive, or another streaming service.
- 4) Complete ALL OF THIS by Feb. 1, 2016.

After you apply:

1. You will receive a confirmation email of your application within 24 hours from either Dr. Van Hof or from CSU graduate student Amanda Tatara.
2. By Feb. 7, you will receive confirmation of your acceptance so you can begin travel plans to get to Fort Collins.
3. If you applied on the form to play in the master class, you will also be notified in the Feb. 7 email.
4. If you are accepted, you must confirm your attendance by Feb. 15, 2016
5. By March 1, 2016, you will receive an email with PDFs of the music, as well as part assignments. This email will also outline the daily schedule for April 7 and 8.
6. If you are accepted and plan to attend, you should arrive in Fort Collins no later than 7:30 a.m. on Thursday, April 7 as events will begin promptly at 8 a.m.
