<sup>3</sup> Students must participate in an ensemble during each semester in which they are enrolled in MU 272A-MU 272V, and MU 472A-MU 472V. At least once during the program of study, this must be achieved by taking MU 408 or through another small ensemble experience. Wind and percussion majors must take MU 204 twice during their four year program.

<sup>4</sup> Wind and percussion majors take MU 420; string majors take MU 421.

<sup>5</sup> Select enough elective credits to bring the program total to a minimum of 120 credits, of which at least 42 must be upper-division (300 - to 400-level).

#### **Additional Requirements: Non-Credit**

\*Sophomore Promotion Interviews with Music Education Faculty take place spring semester of the Sophomore year

\*Students must follow all guidelines specified by the Center for Educator Preparation (CEP) in the CEP handbook regarding the application for student teaching. While the Music Education faculty begin the mentorship process during year 3 of the degree, this is a preamble to the formal application process required by CEP. All CEP guidelines, dates, and processes must be followed in order to student teach.
