<sup>3</sup> Take two semesters of a foreign language during the sophomore year.

<sup>4</sup> Take two semesters each in the junior and senior years.

<sup>5</sup> Select enough elective credits to bring the program total to 120, of which at least 42 must be upper-division (300- to 400-level).

#### **Additional Requirements: Non-Credit**
