Please read all the following bullet points—they are important!

- Audition sign-up sheets will be posted at the UCA on the third floor on the jury/audition board at the top of the stairs by Saturday, January 10, 2026. You must physically sign up for your own audition in the UCA before your audition date. **Do not add slots to the sign-up sheets.**
 - If there are no more sign-up slots available, please email Dr. Bellamy-Lanz immediately at megan.bellamy-lanz@colostate.edu

- Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your audition. Sometimes we get ahead of schedule, and you *may* be asked to play earlier.
- Plan your travel from home accordingly so that you arrive for your normally scheduled audition day and time. There will be **no exceptions** made for students who miss the audition for their instrument. Students should sign up **no less than** 24 hours before their studio's auditions begin.
- Trumpets, trombones, and saxophones who wish to play in both classical and jazz ensembles **must** take separate jazz auditions.
- All audition material is posted on the website at <http://music.colostate.edu/academics/ensembles/auditions/>
- All auditions require prepared etudes/excerpts, scales, and sight-reading.
- All auditions will be blind.
- Results of the auditions will determine placement in Symphony Orchestra, Wind Symphony, and Symphonic Band. All large ensembles rehearse in the afternoon, so please make sure you schedule classes in the morning as much as possible. Ensemble placement will not be determined by your academic schedule, nor your personal preference.
- Audition results will be posted on Wednesday, January 21 by 9am. You will need to sign up for your appropriate class on that date and then plan to attend the first rehearsal of your assigned ensemble. Information about the ensemble's start dates, times, and location of rehearsals will be on the results sheet.
